The site of this year's Conference is Camp Sheppard. A map and directions follow. Be sure to be there between the hours of 12:00 and 1:00 p.m. on Sunday, August 8, 2010. Have lunch before arriving, the first meal served is dinner on Sunday. On Saturday morning, August 14, the last day of the conference, your advisors and/or parents are invited to arrive around 10:00 a.m. and sit in on the final session, where we will discuss what you learned during the week and how to put it to use. ### General Transportation and Arrival Information:

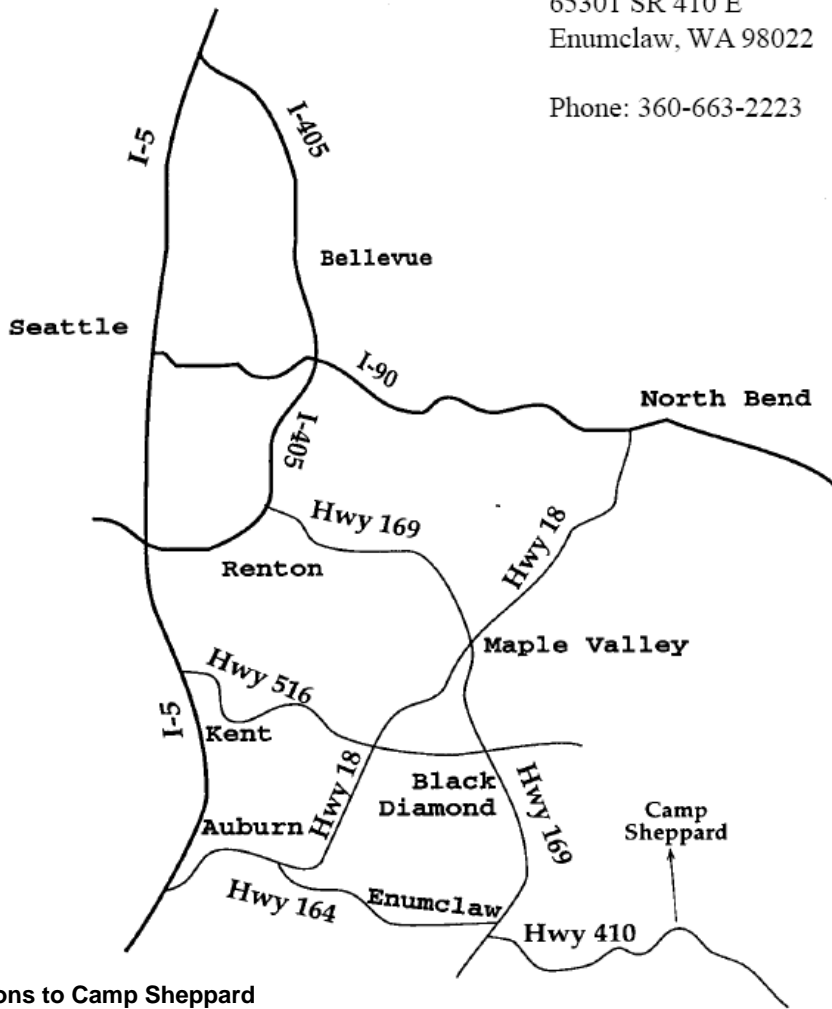
Plan on arriving at the conference site between 12:00 and 1:00 p.m. Sunday, August 8, 2010 having already eaten lunch. The program starts shortly after that time, so a late arrival means you miss part of the opening program. The conference will end Saturday morning, August 14 at about 11:00 am. Parents are invited to arrive that last morning and sit in on the session that begins at 10:00 am. The session summarizes the week and also is designed to set goals and prepare those attending to go home with a plan to make it work for them.

If you have difficulty arranging your transportation to the conference, please contact your Chapter Dad Advisor to see if he can help. If not, have him call your Executive Officer to receive help in riding with someone else attending. If you will be arriving by plane or bus, transportation can be provided from the SeaTac airport or Seattle Greyhound Bus depot to the Camp. Please advise your Executive Officer if you will be arriving by plane or bus. If flying, plan on arriving not later than 9 a.m. on Sunday August 8 and departing not earlier than 3:00 p.m. on Saturday August 14. Overnight home-stays for out-of-state participants can be arranged.

It is important for you to attend the entire conference, since so much of the value of the week at DLC is brought together at the very end of the week. If you are unable to attend from Sunday afternoon until Saturday morning, please contact your Executive Officer immediately. Only he can authorize any late arrival or early departure, and then only if there is some emergency reason. #### Directions to Camp Sheppard

From I-5 heading south from **Seattle** (1 hours 40 minutes)

24 miles south of Seattle, take exit **142A** to merge onto **WA-18 E** toward Auburn. Continue 4.5 miles. Take the **WA-164 E** exit toward Enumclaw. Turn left at **Auburn Way S/WA-164**. Continue to follow **WA-164** for 10 miles. Slight left at **SE 436th St** for 3 miles. Slight left at **SE 440th St/Griffin Ave**. Continue to follow **Griffin Ave** for 2 miles. Turn left at **Roosevelt Ave**. Continue on **SE Enumclaw-Chinook Pass Rd/WA-410**. Drive east out of Enumclaw for 28 miles on **highway 410**. Proceed ½ mile past mile marker 52 and turn left into camp at the Forest Service Camp Sheppard sign on **FS Road 7155**.

From I-5 heading north from **Portland** (3 hours 30 minutes)

135 miles north of Portland, take exit **127** to merge onto **WA-512 E** toward Puyallup. Continue 12 miles. Take the **WA-167 N/WA-410 E** exit toward Yakima/Seattle. Merge onto **WA-167 N**. Take the exit onto **WA-410 E** toward Sumner/Yakima. Drive east for 46 miles on **highway 410**. Proceed ½ mile past mile marker 52 and turn left into camp at the Forest Service Camp Sheppard sign on **FS Road 7155**.

From **Yakima** (2 hours)

Take **US-12** heading West for 47 miles over White Pass. Right on **WA-123** for 16 miles. Slight left to **Mather Memorial Pkwy/WA-410**. Continue on **WA-410** for 13 miles. Turn right on **FS Rd. 7155**, into camp.

From **Spokane**, either:

(5 hours through **Yakima**) Take **I-90 West** for 170 miles. At Ellensburg take exit **110** to merge onto **I-82 East /US-97 South** to Yakima for 32 miles. Take **US-12** heading West for 47 miles over White Pass. Right on **WA-123** for 16 miles. Slight left to **Mather Memorial Pkwy/WA-410**. Continue on **WA-410** for 13 miles. Turn right on **FS Rd. 7155**, into camp.

Or

(5 hours 10 minutes through **Enumclaw**) Take **I-90 West** for 255 miles remaining on **I-90 West** at Ellensburg. Take exit **25** for **WA-18 W** toward Tacoma/Auburn. Turn left at **WA-18** continue 12 miles. Take the exit toward **SE 231st St/Maple Valley/WA-169**. Turn left at **SE 231st St**. Slight right at **SE 232nd St**. Slight right at **Maple Valley Black Diamond Rd SE**. Continue for 13 miles. Becomes **264th Ave SE/Porter St** for 1 mile. Turn left at **Griffin Avenue** for ½ mile. Turn left at **Roosevelt Ave**. Continue on **SE Enumclaw-Chinook Pass Rd/WA-410**. Drive east out of Enumclaw for 28 miles on **highway 410**. Proceed ½ mile past mile marker 52 and turn left into camp at the Forest Service Camp Sheppard sign on **FS Road 7155**.
