You will be given two conference t-shirts when you register. They are to be worn all sessions and meals. Please bring your own casual shirts, preferably any DeMolay shirts you have, for the sporting activities.

Credit cards can be accepted during the conference for purchases over \$5.00. This year, members will be able check-in and check-out their spending money to improve security.

## **General Transportation and Arrival Information:**

Plan on arriving at the conference site NO EARLIER THAN 2:00 P.M. Monday, July 13, 2015 <u>having already eaten lunch</u>. The program starts shortly after that time, so a late arrival means you miss part of the opening program. If you have arranged for early arrival on Sunday to accommodate transportation on the weekend, early arrival on Sunday is **after 3:00 p.m.** for an additional \$25.00 and requires registration for early arrival. The conference will end Sunday morning, July 19 at about 11:30 a.m. which is the final pickup time. Parents are invited to arrive that last morning and sit in on the final session that begins at 10:00 a.m. The session summarizes the week and also is designed to set goals and prepare those attending to go home with a plan to make it work for them.

If you have difficulty arranging your transportation to the conference, please contact your Chapter Dad Advisor to see if he can help. If not, have him call your Executive Officer to receive help in riding with someone else attending. If you will be arriving by plane, or bus, transportation can be provided from the SeaTac airport or Seattle Greyhound Bus depot to the Camp. Please advise your Executive Officer if you will be arriving by plane or bus. If flying, plan on arriving not later than 9 a.m. on Monday, July 13 and departing not earlier than 3:00 p.m. on Sunday, July 19. Overnight home-stays for out-of-state participants can be arranged to accommodate flight dates if necessary (one day earlier arrival or one day later departure).

It is important for you to attend the entire conference, since so much of the value of the week at DLC is brought together at the very end of the week. If you are unable to attend from Sunday afternoon until Saturday morning, please contact your Executive Officer immediately. Only he can authorize any late arrival or early departure, and then only if there is some emergency reason.
