BRING / DON'T BRING LISTS

REQUIRED:

- A light jacket or coat
- Casual pants (jeans, etc.)
- Shorts
- Underwear
- Personal toiletries (including soap and deodorant)
- Sleeping bag (sheets & blanket) & pillow
- Bath towels, washcloth, shower needs
- Tennis shoes & socks (appropriate for Sports)
- A spare shirt or two for sports
- Flashlight (small pocket light or phone)

Recommended:

- DeMolay Handbook
- Sunscreen lotion
- Bug repellent – we do get mosquitos
- DeMolay Ritual
- Camera
- Slippers, crocks, or flip flops

Not Allowed:

- Illegal substances
- Alcohol
- Marijuana in any form
- Cigarettes, e-cigarettes/vaporizers
- Weapons, knives, etc.
- Fireworks
- iPads, iPods, MP3 players
- Large sums of cash
- Any type of video game
- Expensive items you don't want damaged

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

PARENTAL CONSENT/MEDICAL RELEASE: If you have not already done so, submit your [medical release form online](#). You must have one on file to be at PNWDLC.

CONDUCT: You are expected to conduct yourself in accordance with appropriate DeMolay standards during your time at the PNWDLC. There is a zero-tolerance policy for behavior that puts the health and safety of you or others at risk. Your parents have agreed to be available to be contacted at any time during camp if necessary. They understand that should you be required to leave camp for disciplinary reasons, they are responsible for your transportation.

PHONES: You will be asked to keep your phones put away. The cell signal at the camp is very poor and parents should not expect that you will be able to call with any consistency. If your phones become a distraction, we will ask you to have your advisor hold it for you until the week concludes. If there is an emergency, the camp has a land line with an answering machine to make sure you can be reached.

MONEY: You may want to bring some spending money with you. You will not be allowed to leave the conference site, but the **DLC STORE** will be open for your convenience; to purchase limited DeMolay clothing, snacks and other items. ***(Please do not bring a large amount of money with you).***

WATER: You will receive a water bottle so that you can stay hydrated during your time at camp. Some years we get very high temps, and it is critical to stay hydrated.

MEDICATIONS: Please make sure all medications are in original containers with instructions for when and how much should be taken. You will turn in the medications in with the medical advisor so they can ensure proper disbursement.

SHIRTS: You will receive 2 shirts that you will wear on an alternating daily rotation throughout the week. We have laundry for those shirts to keep them clean while you are at camp during the week.

WEBSITE: During the week we will make updates and post them to the [website](#). We encourage your parents to check it out.

DRIVING/PARKING: You should avoid driving yourself to camp. The only parking is at a Northwest Forestry trailhead parking lot. Leaving a car there for an extended time leaves it vulnerable to vandalism and theft. It would also require a NW Forestry Park Pass or be subject to citation.

TRAVEL PLANS

Sunday Arrival

Plan to arrive at the conference site between **12:00 pm and 1:00 pm** on **SUNDAY, July 27, 2025**. If you arrive before noon and the registration is not open, you and your chaperone will need to wait. Your chaperone should not drop and go. They should remain onsite until you have completed the registration/check-in process. We understand that many of the chaperones have a long drive home and we will do our best to get people on the road.

When you arrive, please park in the parking lot down below the camp gate. There will be someone there greeting you and directing you about where to take your stuff. The **program will begin at 1:30 pm** for the whole camp so a late arrival means that you'll miss part of the opening program.

Parents and Advisors are invited to arrive Saturday morning (August 2nd) at 10:30 am and enjoy A-Week-In-Review video, listen to the DLC Chapter Master Councilors remarks, witness firsthand who earns the coveted designation of DeMolay of the Week, and more. **The conference will end on Saturday, August 2nd at about 11:30 am and your ride home should arrive no later than 12:00 pm.**
